10. The applicant agrees to abide by the following conditions during the period the Agreement is in effect:

- a) Comply with relevant certification program provisions as stated in CS-01, Product Certification Scheme for Formaldehyde Emissions, and QP-14 – Certification Process CARB including implementing appropriate changes when identified and required by Prime.
- b) For certifications that apply to ongoing production, the Client shall ensure that products placed on the market continue to comply with the applicable product requirements and certification criteria.
- c) Make necessary arrangements for the conduct of site evaluations and surveillance activities, including access to records, audit reports, personnel, complaint records, and other information necessary for conformity assessment activities.
- d) The Client shall make claims regarding certification only in a manner consistent with the scope of certification granted by Prime Certification Services.
- e) Never use its product certification mark or certification shipping document in misleading or unauthorized ways.
- f) Discontinue use of certification upon suspension or cancellation.
- g) When providing copies of certification documents to others, the Client shall reproduce them in their entirety or as specified by the certification scheme.
- h) In making reference to its product certification in communication media such as documents, brochures, or advertising, the Client shall comply with the requirements of Prime Certification Services and the applicable certification scheme.
- i) comply with any requirements of the certification scheme relating to the use of marks of conformity and product information.
- j) The Client shall keep a record of all complaints made known to it relating to compliance with certification requirements, make these records available to Prime Certification Services upon request, take appropriate actions with respect to such complaints and any deficiencies found in products that affect compliance with certification requirements, and document the actions taken.
- k) Informs Prime of changes that may affect its ability to conform to certification requirements.
- l) Inspections for CARB and EPA TSCA are only performed as part of Prime CARB and EPA TSCA Product certification activities.
- m) The applicant acknowledges and agrees to comply with all applicable regulatory requirements under CARB ATCM (CCR 93120) and EPA TSCA Title VI (40 CFR Part 770), including ongoing compliance, mandatory reporting, recordkeeping, corrective actions, and enforcement actions imposed by the applicable regulatory authorities.

11. Prime shall be responsible for the management of all information obtained during product certification, inspection activities and externally performed testing activities. Except for information that the applicant makes publicly available, all other information shall be considered confidential unless required by law.

12. Prime is required, however, to notify the EPA of the following applicant/client information:

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- Approved or rejected applications (including renewals) for NAF or ULEF certification exemptions or reduced testing,
- Exceedances of established quality control limits for three consecutive quality control tests,
- Each failed quarterly test (where a sample exceeds the applicable emissions standards)

Additionally, Prime must provide an annual report to the EPA which contains the following customer information:

- A list of products and product types and resin systems used that Prime has certified,
- Results of quarterly tests,
- Information on non-complying lots, and
- Corrective actions resulting from quarterly tests and inspections.

13. Prime may, at its discretion, subcontract inspection activities to qualified inspection bodies and testing activities to qualified external laboratories.

14. Prime Product Certification Scheme for Formaldehyde Emissions (CS-01), identifies all regulatory requirements as well as Prime Formaldehyde Emissions Program implementation documents.
